Sesemi Electronics Ltd requires its suppliers to take steps to eliminate the risk of introducing both counterfeit electronic parts as well as non-electronic parts and material. We define counterfeit work as items that are or contain unlawful or unauthorised reproductions, substitutions or alterations that have been knowingly mismarked, misidentified or otherwise misrepresented to be authentic, unlawful or unauthorised substitution includes used items represented as new or false identification of grade, serial number, lot number and date code or performance characteristics.

Sesemi Electronics Ltd depends on you, our supplier base to be partners with us in our efforts to combat counterfeit part infiltration into our products and all our supplier should have a robust counterfeit part control plans that meet or exceed any industry and any applicable government standards and review the following precautions.

- Training for the detection and prevention of counterfeit parts
- Risk based processes for inspection and test to aid the detection of counterfeit items.
- Processes that ensure traceability of procured items back to the original manufacturer.
- Procurement processes that utilise original component manufacturers or their authorised distributors
- The flow down of counterfeit detection and avoidance requirements to all sub-tier suppliers.
